

EVENT DIRECTOR'S UPDATE

Just back from the second major survey for this year. True to form we had another couple of “survey disasters”! First was a torsion bar bolt coming loose which badly affected the steering, and being the “mechanics” we are we didn’t have the tools to fix it! However, someone must have been watching from above as we were able to ‘struggle’ only about 20 kilometers to a small town that had a competent, and very obliging, mechanic with a hoist. Next thing, the Terra Trip decided to catch fire and burn itself to smithereens! Needless to say yet another trip in a few weeks’ time will be necessary to accurately plot the final few stages; the odometer just doesn’t cut it when it comes to producing your Bible (Road Book).

Apart from that all is looking good for this year’s event. Some of the areas in the high country are spectacular and subject to snow, so could be interesting! Those of you who were with us a few years ago, will remember rallying through falling snow in the ‘picture-postcard’ area of Aberfeldy in Victoria. This is in the same vicinity....Highest we reached this time was about 1,430 metres so be prepared as anything could happen, although the climb over the ranges is on fairly well maintained roads so fingers crossed. This will be followed by an all bitumen stage of 66 kms which twists and turns a lot and will be a Class 4.

There will also be some beaut roads on a visual navigation section where the navigator will need to make sure his/her eyes are working well that day.

As with other years in the South Australian areas there will be the customary sand tracks, of which only the best have been selected to avoid being bogged for several hours.

We have now sorted the overnight and lunch stops, see next page for all the details. This also means that the accommodation list is now available and has been emailed to everyone. Those without emails will have had the list faxed or posted to them. Please let us know if you haven’t received a copy. It is advisable to book quickly if you don’t relish sleeping on the ground, especially in the smaller places where there aren’t many beds. New entrants take note please!!

The order process is as follows: (Contact me on 1300 300 544 if you need more info)

- Orders will need to be placed via the myplates call centre on **131 758**
- Customer is to nominate the registry from which they can pick up their plates
- Payment will be made at the time of order - order fee: **\$130.00** per set (one-off)
- Delivery will be within 2-3 weeks. Only available for NSW registered kars
- Have your existing plates made in the rally format, sample above, or order new plates of your choice in this format, annual fees apply on all new personalised plates
If you are already paying an annual fee it will continue, but if you've had your plates prior to the annual fees being introduced your rally plates will not incur an annual fee.
- Plate dimensions 372x107mm front and rear
