## Event Director's Update – John Paine

It is pleasing to see that some of you are starting to make significant inroads into your fundraising but obviously with the cut off for fundraising closing in at the end of July, time will pass all too quickly so now is the time to organise yourselves.

For those yet to enter may I remind you that I must have received your Entry Form and the \$250 Entry Fee by the 30<sup>th</sup> June otherwise you will miss out on what is shaping up to be a very interesting Rally.

The course that I have chosen is ready for the final course check in early June notwithstanding several final approvals from State Forests and Parks in NSW, ACT and Victoria. This has consumed a lot of time coordinating all the paperwork with the various organisations who own and manage these State assets but I am sure it will be worth it come Rally time.

I will shortly be advising all entrants of the details regarding pre-event scrutineering times and locations and whilst on this subject the Rally Advisory Committee have asked me to remind the Back Up crews of their vehicle obligations. Back up Kars **MUST** be capable of retrieving (Towing) their Rally Kar should it be necessary which means your vehicle must be fitted with a suitable tow hook and a bar to flat tow out of a Rally section. This means the Sweeps will not be obligated to recover your Rally Kar. Also, Back Up Crews are reminded that you are only allowed to enter a Rally section **AFTER** the last Kar and be capable of staying ahead of the Sweeps.

## Vehicle & Personal Forms:

Thank you to those Entrants who have returned their Vehicle information and Personal Profile / Medical forms to me and to those that haven't yet done so you really need to get it done so I can order your year badges, Shirts and allow our Scorers etc. to start work on their spreadsheets. **Please return to John ASAP.**

## Changes to the Auction:

Following input from various sources regarding the Auction Nights we have found it necessary to make some significant changes to the Auction process. The reasons for this are mainly to cut down on the time and effort this process has been taking in the past and to free up the evenings proceedings. Another significant factor for these changes is to reduce the complexity of carrying over funds raised to the following year.

The Event Organisers also strongly believe that whilst the fundraising results have raised a reasonable amount from past auctions it places an unfair impost on Entrants own pockets whilst on the Rally plus we would rather see the Entrants who provide the Auction items organise their own Auction nights or Raffle the items pre-event to increase their fundraising totals.

Starting from this year we will strictly enforce these rules;

- The Auction will **ONLY** be conducted on the **opening night**.
- Each item must be **valued over \$100** and each vehicle is capped to a **maximum of 3 items**
- Only the **best 40 items** submitted within the cut off date will be accepted. **Cut off date is Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2018**. Email details and a brief description of item, along with an attached photo to Heather and Sarah at [events@kidney.org.au](mailto:events@kidney.org.au). Bring your approved items to the rally and give to Heather or Sarah.
- **No additional items are to be** offered for Auction during the Rally.
- Any **Items not purchased** at Auction are the responsibility of the donor and are to be returned to the donor after the auction closes.
- Funds from items sold at the first nights auction will be added to the current years fundraising and **will NOT be carried forward** to the following year.
- Please consider if your item(s) would appeal to the wider audience. (E.G. NO Footy Team items etc.) The Event Organisers reserve the right to have the final decision on whether items will go to auction. Barto (Our Esteemed Auctioneer) does not need the practice to auction interstate Club type footy stuff!!

Obviously, we will not be able to use funds raised at the opening nights auction to influence your daily starting position or the highest fundraising awards presented at the Presentation dinner.
